Is there a Camp Handbook?

Yes, the handbook can be found on-line at www.sbschools.org, under Community Education. It will be available in the near future.

Will my camper need to bring lunch and snacks to camp?

This summer, enrollment in Camp 678 **includes a hot or cold lunch** at no additional cost provided by Chartwells Food Service. To view the lunch menu, go to <http://sbschools.nutrislice.com/> and choose Middle Schools, and then Crossroads South. Menus for June and July are available to view now.

- On days when your child eats lunch at Camp 678, your child will make his/her selection on the lunch line. You do not pre-order lunch.
- On most trip days, a cold bagged lunch will be prepared for your child. You will need to pre-order your child's cold lunch for trip days by the day before the trip. Place your order online using the website above. If you do not pre-order, your child will be given the vegetarian option.

If your child does not want to participate in the lunch program, you must bring your child's lunch in a brown paper bag with his/her name clearly marked. A mid-morning and mid-afternoon snack are also included in camp.

When there is a field trip, and my child doesn't want to attend, will someone be at camp?

All children must go on the field trip.

What if my child takes medication?

All of you received paperwork re: camp in the mail. A medical release form was included in that packet. You must submit this form to the camp Nurse in order for your camper to be allowed to take their medications.

Does this pertain to over-the-counter medication?

Yes, any medication, whether doctor prescribed or over-the-counter, needs to be taken with the Nurse's supervision. And, you need to submit the forms for this as well.

When does my child need to wear a camp t-shirt?

Your child needs to wear their camp t-shirt on all field trips. This helps the staff to easily identify the Adventure camp students.

When will my child receive their camp shirt?

T-shirts will be distributed during the first week of the first session that your child attends. Each camper will receive one t-shirt for the summer.

Can my child wear camp t-shirts from previous summers?

Yes. As long as the shirt bears the Community Ed logo, your child can wear it on a trip.

How will I know who my child's counselors are?

Photos of all camp staff will be posted on the camp bulletin board near the building entrance. Also, all staff are required to wear a district issued badge to identify them as district staff.

Will field trips always return before 4:00?

This year, some of the field trips are scheduled to return by 4:30. The realities of NJ traffic have made it difficult for us to promise a 4:00 return time.
