SAT Preparation Classes for May 5 or June 2, 2018 Test

Focus on shortcuts, study techniques, test-taking skills and strategies, format and scoring. Tuition includes review materials. It is important to remember that the more a student studies, the greater the benefit of any preparation course. This preparation course consists of instruction in verbal, writing and math preparation covering all facets of the test. Parents are responsible for transporting student to and from school. **Students must bring a calculator to math class.**

Reading/Writing: 4:30-6:30 pm or 6:35-8:35 pm

6 Mondays: March 12, 19, April 2, 9, 16, 23 (inclement weather make-up will be April 30)

Math: 4:30-6:30 pm or 6:35-8:35 pm

6 Tuesdays: March 13, 20, April 3, 10, 24, May 1 (inclement weather make-up will be Thurs. May 3)

Tuition: \$210 for each class, total of \$420 if taking both subjects.
