2. Enter the Community "South Brunswick Community Education Summer Programs, Tennis and Adult School" and hit the continue button.
3. On the next screen, read the 3 options listed to determine if you are considered an Existing User or New User. If you are unsure, please call for assistance.
4. Once you log in and hit the "Register/Browse Activities" button, then select the season "Spring 2017 Tennis" and hit the continue button.
5. You are now ready to verify your account information, then select and pay for the Tennis classes you would like to sign up for.
