Dear Families,


This winter's weather and the need to make-up emergency closing days result in a need for changes in our school calendar. And while we had planned for up to 8 emergency closing make-up days, the last two emergency closing days occurring so late in the school year – March 7 and March 8 – and so close to our scheduled Spring Break bring about a reason to revisit our school calendar.

To review our school calendar to date: with the emergency closing of schools on January 4 and 5, **schools will now be in session on May 25 & May 29**, and identified in our school calendar as make-up days #1 & #2. As mentioned, with the recent school closings on March 7 and 8 (and (April 2 and March 26 previously identified as make-up days 3 and 4) occurring so close to Spring Break and families and staff possibly having made plans for Spring Break, we feel it is in the best interests of all to revise the school calendar as follows:

- **School will be in session on April 2 as planned as make-up day #3;**
- With Board of Education approval on March 19, 2018, we will eliminate the 181st instructional day for students, changing the day to a professional development day for staff. This change eliminates the need for a *school in session day* on March 26.
Therefore, schools will be closed for Spring Break March 26 through March 30.

Thank you for your patience during this *stormy* winter.
