

Scoring Criteria

It is the intent of the Local Education Agency (LEA) to accept the proposal that will best promote the public interest and is most advantageous to the LEA. All responsive proposals will be evaluated by a team of individuals whose total scores will be averaged.

The primary factor in the award shall be the price offered to the LEA for services rendered or proposed.

Proposals will be evaluated by the following 5 evaluation criterion. They are weighted based upon the importance to the LEA. The point range is 1-10, with 10 being the highest and 1 being the lowest. Following the scoring of proposals they will be ranked.

The contract may then be awarded to the company submitting the top-ranked proposal, or the LEA may seek to conduct negotiations with those companies submitting proposals receiving a pre-determined cut-off score. Any such negotiations will be conducted in a fair and equitable manner.

- Only Vendors that address all criterion listed below will be considered responsive
- Each of the evaluation criterion should be addressed in detail in the Vendor's proposal

Evaluation Criterion	Weighting Factor

1. Price (this criterion must be the primary factor in the award decision)	25%
2. Clarity of proposed services and demonstration of preventative maintenance in like districts.	20%
3. The vendors demonstration of developing athletic field improvement projects and managing their job scope.	25%
4. The accuracy of data submitted to support the RFP. Submission of all required forms	15%
5. Evidence of capability and experience as measured by performance record, years in the industry, relevant experience, number of School Districts served, client retention, and references.	15%
