Good Afternoon Brunswick Acres Families,

Due to two separate unrelated positive cases at our school, along with potential transmission, it will be necessary, as per CDC guidelines, for Brunswick Acres to close for 14 days from the initial time that symptoms of the first positive case began. This means that both our Special Education program and our Remote Learning Center will not be operating until November 30th.

We know that this is a very unfortunate and unwelcome disruption only a week prior to Thanksgiving and only a day after starting the RLC program back up. Further, based upon what is happening with Covid right now in our state and our world, the operative term we all need to keep at the forefront is FLEXIBILITY. The rules associated with cases in schools are strict and based upon the daily 4,000+ positive cases being reported in the state, we may be in for more disruption to our plans. Our number one priority remains the safety of our students and staff. I gave up making predictions many months ago, but I want to reiterate the need for us all to brace for this second wave and its impact on our schools.
