Mr. Harry Delgado on behalf of the board and staff welcomed Mr. Scott Feder to his first board meeting.

<u>SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT</u> – Mr. Scott Feder

- Mr. Feder announced he has been visiting various schools and departments and meeting with staff. He also met with the SBEA leadership. Mrs. Madeline Daniels, Assistant to the Superintendent will arrange for meetings with board members.
- During the Administrative Council meeting held earlier in the day a new district theme was announced *My approach creates the climate; my mood makes the weather.* ~ *Make it a sunny day!* Mr. Feder thanked the Administrative team for their help.
- Mr. Feder announced the ESIP project is on schedule and the general maintenance of the summer is ongoing. He thanked Building and Grounds Director, Todd Amiet for his work and overseeing the project. Dr. McCartney also has been giving support on the ESIP project.
- Powerschool software is transitioning to Genesis software. Parents will receive an email with information on passwords.
- Interviews are taking place for the Director of Technology, Middle School Language Arts Supervisor and Business Administrator. Mr. Thaddeus Thompson, Business Administrator has agreed to stay on until a new business administrator is appointed.
- A reminder for parents that live in South Brunswick and have children eligible for kindergarten to enroll them as soon as possible.
- Summer reading lists have been updated and will be available online.
- The next board meeting will be held on Monday, August 28th, 2017.

Mr. Feder announced he was beyond excited about starting the school year and thanked Mrs. Kimberly Maloy-White, Assistant Superintendent for Human Resources and Administration and Ms. Jennifer Diszler, Assistant Superintendent for Curriculum, Instruction and Administration for their support and work.

Ms. Diszler reported on the Ant-Bullying Bill of Rights Act (ABR) School and District Grade Report for the 2016 – 2017 school year and announced the district did very well (a maximum total score for a school is 78 points) the district's overall grade average is 75.9 (97%).
