Dear Parents/Guardians,

We have received the Individual Student Reports (ISRs) from the Spring 2019 New Jersey Student Learning Assessments (NJSLA) administration. Your child's report(s) have been posted to the [Genesis Parent Portal](#). You will receive one for English Language Arts/Literacy (ELA) and/or one for Mathematics based on the tests your child took last spring. You are encouraged to print and keep a copy for your records. These assessments measure your child's academic performance with grade level content standards as defined in the New Jersey Student Learning Standards. The NJSLA results are a "snapshot" of your child's performance on a standardized measure and compare his/her performance to peers in South Brunswick and New Jersey.

**Coming Late Fall:** The State is offering a new resource for the 2019 ELA and mathematics results through an online portal for parents/guardians. The online portal will include the student's scale score, quick access to resources that fit your student's needs, and a video score report. The portal will also allow for you to track your student's scores from year to year, beginning with Spring 2019. To access the online portal, you must create an account using the unique claim code that is located on your student's paper ISR. You will be able to access the New Jersey parent portal in early October 2019.

In South Brunswick, we use multiple measures to understand your child's academic profile and to plan instruction to meet his/her needs. Since class performance is what is most important, the teachers will continue to closely monitor your child's academic progress throughout the year. You are encouraged to stay informed and remain in communication with your child's classroom teachers.
