The undersigned does hereby make application for exhibitor space at the 15th Annual SBHS Project Graduation Craft Show for Saturday, November 30, 2019. If accepted as a participating crafter/vendor, the undersigned agrees to abide by the following conditions:

- 1. Payment in full is required by November 5, 2019. Any payments received after that date must be by money order. All checks returned to use by the bank for non-payment will be subject to a \$30 fee.
- 2. Cancellations must be made in writing no less than 30 days prior to the event for a full refund. Cancellations received less than 30 days prior to the event will not be refunded.
- 3. All registered crafters may arrive to set-up at 7:30 am, Saturday, November 30, 2019 and no later than 9:30 am. Pre-assigned space not guaranteed after check-in time, but a space will be provided. The Craft Fair will begin promptly at 10:00 am and ends at 4:00 pm. The crafter/vendor agrees to adhere to advertised show hours. **Early packing or leaving will not be allowed**. Doing so may cause confusion with the other crafters/vendors and attendees.
- 4. The crafter/vendor agrees to obtain all necessary permits and licenses and comply with any local ordinances (state sales tax, fire codes, etc.) before the event; to file all required tax forms; and to pay all state and local taxes from sales at the event.
- 5. The South Brunswick High School and the Project Graduation Committee shall not be responsible for any injury, loss, or legal action that may arise or come to the crafter/vendor or his/her goods or to the public from any cause whatsoever while craft fair premises are being occupied under this agreement. Crafters/Vendors are responsible for their own insurance coverage and waive all claims for personal injury, damages to persons or property, including but not limited to medical expenses, suits, fees, etc. howsoever incurred against the SBHS.

Directions: FROM TRENTON/PRINCETON AREA: Route 1 North to Ridge Road, turn right, follow Ridge Road for approximately 2 miles. The High School is on the left.

FROM NEW BRUNSWICK AREA: Route 1 South to Promenade Blvd. Take first jug handle after Promenade Blvd across from Route 1 to Route 522. Take the first right onto Stouts Lane. Follow Stouts Lane to its end (Ridge Road) the High School is on your right.

FROM NEW JERSEY TURNPIKE SOUTH: Exit at 8A Jamesburg. Make a left at traffic light to next light. Turn right onto Rt. 32 West toward Route 130. Take Route 130 North (to the right). About 2 miles from this intersection, at the first traffic light, exit to the left onto Route 522 toward Dayton. Continue on Route 522. About 3-4 miles on the left, before you get to Route 1, you will see a sign on the left: STOUTS LANE SBHS. Make a left onto Stouts Lane. Continue down Stouts Lane, the High School is on your right at the end of the road. SBHS is located at the corner of Stouts Lane and Ridge Road.

FROM NEW JERSEY TURNPIKE NORTH: Exit at 8A Jamesburg and follow directions above from NJ Turnpike South.

FROM ROUTE 287: Exit at Easton Avenue. At 2nd light, Cedar Grove Lane (Route 619) turn right. Continue on Amwell Road traffic light. Turn left and travel to South Middlebush Road (Route 615). Turn right at this corner (Stage House Restaurant is up ahead on the left). Follow South Middlebush Road to end, which leaves you at Route 27 and Sand Hill Road. Continue straight onto Sand Hill Road to Route 1 South (McDonald's is on your right hand side). Make right onto Route 1 South. At third light (Stouts Lane). Take first jug handle after Promenade Blvd across from Route 1 to Route 522. Take the first right onto Stouts Lane. Follow Stouts Lane to its end (Ridge Road) the High School is on your right.
